BTEI Courses

Under the Back to Education Initiative (BTEI) part-time programme, learners can gain a QQI (formerly FETAC) accreditation. BTEI courses are free to those who did not complete a Leaving Cert., those in receipt of medical cards and most social welfare recipients.

PPS number must be submitted prior to starting BTEI course.

Community Education

This programme aims to provide a locally based education programme that is responsive to the local community's needs. PPS number must be given before starting course.

Community Groups are welcome to contact the centre directly if they would like a course for their group.

Adult Literacy and Basic Education

This programme is a free and confidential service for adults who wish to improve their reading, writing, spelling and maths or learn a little about computers. You can work *1 to 1* with a tutor or be part of a small group. You decide what you want to work on and learn at your own pace.

Courses related to Health and Caring

Carers' Modules

Care Support QQI Level 5

This module aims to assist you to recognise the different types of clients needing care, different types of care needs and the different care needs of clients. It will equip you with the skills, knowledge and competence to care for clients in a safe and hygienic environment.

PLC (Post Leaving Certificate)

Tourism with Business 5M5011

Course Description

This QQI Level 5 programme is designed to enable learners to carry out a range of business and administrative functions in tourism related enterprises and provide a solid foundation for success in a business career with a special focus on tourism. 1.5 million tourists pass through Caherciveen annually, we are on the Ring of Kerry, Kerry Way, Wild Atlantic Way and the Dark Sky Reserve. Capitalise on our tourism and business opportunities.

Course Content

Bookkeeping – Manual & Computerised, Customer Service, Word Processing, Irish Cultural & Heritage Resources, Event production, Tourism Information & Administration, Tourism Principles & Practice, Work Experience.

Entry Requirement: Applicants should have Leaving Certificate, LCVP, LCA or a Level 4 Certificate. Mature applicants are very welcome. Access to this programme will be decided by interview.

Work Experience: Work experience forms an integral part of this O’Connell Centre Programme. Students participate in quality placements allowing a valuable opportunity to gain hands-on experience in the tourism industry and apply the skills acquired on the course in a work setting.

Career Opportunities: Because of the broad spectrum of subjects, career opportunities are numerous. The knowledge and skills gained by students make them

an attractive proposition for any employer or for self-employment in the Tourist Industry.

Progression to Further Education and Higher Education

On successful completion of this Level 5 course, learners can progress to Tourism with Business Level 6. Students who achieve this Level 5 Major award are also eligible to apply to courses of Higher Education Level. Students are advised to check with the individual college regarding entry requirements. Students enrolled on this course will also have guidance available to them.

VTOS (Vocational Training Opportunity Scheme)

General Learning 3M0874

Employment Skills 4M0857

This is a full-time, Monday to Friday, 2 year programme with South Kerry VTOS. This programme aims to develop the core skills needed for further learning and to prepare adults returning to education to progress to further education/training or to employment.

Course Content: Communications, Maths, Computers, Personal & Interpersonal Skills, Art & Design, Woodcraft, Ceramics and Work Experience.

Entry Requirements: Age 21 or over, unemployed for at least 6 months OR in receipt of a qualifying Social Welfare payment OR signing for credits for at least 6 months OR have received Statutory Redundancy.

Applicants will retain their entitlements.

Garda Vetting is required.

Application Details: Application forms are available from Centre. Interviews will apply for all applicants.
